



## **About the Future Ready Project**

Achieve launched the Future Ready Project to help create a favorable environment in which the collegeand career-ready agenda continues to gain ground, and continues to be on the radar screen of state leaders in a time of competing priorities and tight budgets. This initiative will arm advocates – be them policymakers, K-12 and postsecondary educators, or business leaders – with the tools, information, strategies and support they need to successfully champion the college- and career-ready agenda in their states and communities.

There are two major elements of the Future Ready Project: The Future Ready Project resource center and the Future Ready Project State Partnership.

The Future Ready Project resource center is a web-based, one-stop shop for the information and strategies needed to effectively advocate for the college- and career-ready agenda, and includes the following:

**Future Ready Facts:** Fact sheets on the major topics of the college- and career-ready agenda, such as graduation requirements, college- and career-ready standards and more. This section also includes existing advocacy materials, such as Achieve's Math Works series and materials developed by partner organizations.

**Future Ready Research:** The latest national survey/poll data and an archive of new and relevant research reports, to arm advocates with useful information.

**Future Ready Tools:** Tools and templates that clearly lay out the steps to building and sustaining a collegeand career-ready communications strategy to jumpstart planning at the local and state levels.

**Future Ready Strategies:** Strategies on how to make the Future Ready Project happen in a state, whether the goal is to educate audiences, advocate for the agenda, talk to the media, reach students etc.

**Future Ready Exchange:** Existing and ongoing national, state and local campaigns with messages, audiences and/or issues relevant to the college- and career-ready agenda. States and organizations are encouraged to submit their own resources to add to the Exchange.

**In Your State:** Links to state-specific fact sheets developed by Achieve and other organizations, to help bolster advocacy efforts with state data.

## The Future Ready State Partnership

Building on the tools and resources in the Future Ready Project resource center, Achieve is partnering with a select set of states to develop actionable communications and outreach initiatives tailored to meet states' policy and advocacy challenges around the college- and career-ready agenda.
